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Rules of Procedure for the Student Political Council

Purpose

The Student Political Council is a body for cooperation and consultation between the Union Board and the sections regarding student political issues. The Council exists to address and pursue strategic student political issues within Göta studentkår. The Council also serves as a platform for discussions on student political issues, the planning of advocacy campaigns, and the exchange of experiences concerning student political matters among Göta studentkår's elected representatives with responsibility for student political issues.

Composition

The Council shall consist of Göta studentkår's Vice Chairperson, members of the Union Board appointed by the Union Board, and members of the Section Boards with responsibility for student political issues. The members of the Student Political Council shall be reported to the Management Council after the Union Board of Göta studentkår has decided that the Council shall be active.

Göta studentkår's Vice Chairperson shall convene the Council and holds ultimate responsibility for its activities.

Duties

The Student Political Council shall:

- › Work on matters in the operational plan relating to student politics.
- › Continuously follow up on work concerning matters in the operational plan relating to student politics.
- › Act as a forum for discussion on student politics within Göta studentkår.

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- › Plan and implement advocacy campaigns.
- › Work to ensure that the Student Union remains aware of external developments relevant to student politics.
- › Continuously work to update Göta studentkår's policy document in consultation with the Education Council.
- › Prepare matters relating to Göta studentkår's work within Göteborgs förenade studentkårer (GFS).
- › Prepare matters relating to Göta studentkår's work within Sveriges förenade studentkårer (SFS).
- › Act as a consultative body for student political matters within Göta studentkår.

Meetings

The Student Political Council shall meet regularly, at least four (4) times per semester.

The Vice Chairperson shall summon members of the council to a meeting at least ten (10) days in advance. The notice of meeting shall include the time and place of the meeting. The agenda and any accompanying documents shall be distributed to the members of the council no later than three (3) days prior to the meeting. Minutes shall be taken and distributed to the members of the council and shall also be made available to the members of The Union Board via the internal server.

Göta studentkår's board members and staff have the right to attend the council's meetings.

Organization and Authority

The board creates councils and determines their composition and purpose. The council reports to the board and shall provide regular updates.

The council may submit proposals for decisions regarding student political matters to the board.

Onboarding

At the end of the operational year, the council is responsible for compiling a report on its work and achievements during its term of office. The person responsible for the council

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shall also, during the summer handover period, ensure that the incoming responsible person receives adequate information regarding the council's purpose, function, and administration.

This document shall be kept up to date and adopted annually at the beginning of each operational year.

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
