Göta studentkår's terms and conditions of membership

Göta studentkår is a non-profit organization based on membership and voluntary engagement. However, you are not required to engage in any activities to become a member; becoming a member of the student union is all that is needed.

As a member of Göta studentkår you support the work of the student union. You become a part of us and contribute to strengthening our legitimacy to advocate for student matters and exert student influence at the University of Gothenburg. The more members we have, the stronger our voice becomes.

Through your membership, you ensure that the student union can continue to address issues that enhance your education and student life in Gothenburg. Together, we ensure that you and your fellow students have the right to a secure time at the university, access to good study spaces, increased teacher-led instructional time, fair examinations, and social activities alongside your studies.

To become a full-fledged member of Göta studentkår, you are required to be a registered student in one of the faculties that Göta studentkår represents. As a full-fledged member, you have the right to influence the union's activities, for instance, by voting in the union election, serving as a student representative, presenting your suggestions and opinions to your section, initiating an association, and serving as a member of your section's board or The Representative Assembly (the highest decision-making body of the union).

Union Identification

Your membership certificate serves as your identification (driver's license, ID card, passport) in combination with:

It is your responsibility to be able to present this in situations where you need to demonstrate your membership in the student union.

Personal data

Göta studentkår collects personal information about all registered students from The University of Gothenburg. As a member, you agree that Göta studentkår handles these tasks as well and that we may share your information with partners in order to be able to offer you benefits and discounts. Payment

Paid support membership is non-refundable. Paid full membership fee is non-refundable. Exceptions to this are only made if the payment has gone to the wrong student union, meaning that the student is not represented by Göta studentkår and should pay a fee for another student union.
